4. FIRST AID MEASURES

Major Spills: Clear area. Alert Fire Brigade. Wear full protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Contain and prevent entry into drains and waterways. Do not discharge into sewer or environment.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

Handling: Avoid contact and inhalation. Wear protective clothing when exposure risk exists. Do not allow wet clothing to remain in contact with skin.

Storage: Store sealed in original containers in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area. Keep away from acids, acid chlorides, acid anhydrides, and foodstuff containers.
